STUDENT CRITERIA:

1. Student must be enrolled at Cerritos College at the time of application
2. Student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at the end of Fall 2024
3. Student must have either completed 2 Philosophy courses (6 units) or completed 1 Philosophy course (3 units) and *currently enrolled in a second*.

WHAT TO SUBMIT:

1. A PHILOSOPHICAL ESSAY

Please submit an argumentative essay (word-processed, doubled spaced, at least 750 words) on a philosophical topic to Areté by **Tuesday, March 31st**.

2. YOUR TRANSCRIPT

Students MUST provide a current transcript and be in good standing with a grade point average (G.P.A.) of 3.0 or higher. Due **Tuesday, March 31st**.

3. A COMPLETED APPLICATION

Complete the application and questions listed on the next page. **Tuesday, March 31st**.
