We asked for engagement and collaboration, and you did not disappoint; we enjoyed an 89 percent attendance rate at today's Return to Campus Forum. With 396 attendees viewing for an average of 96 minutes, I believe we experienced our highest attendance at any forum since I began at Cerritos College. Collectively, you submitted over 179 separate questions during the event. I could not be more impressed with the level of engagement we experienced, particularly because it is sometimes challenging to feel engaged in a virtual format.
