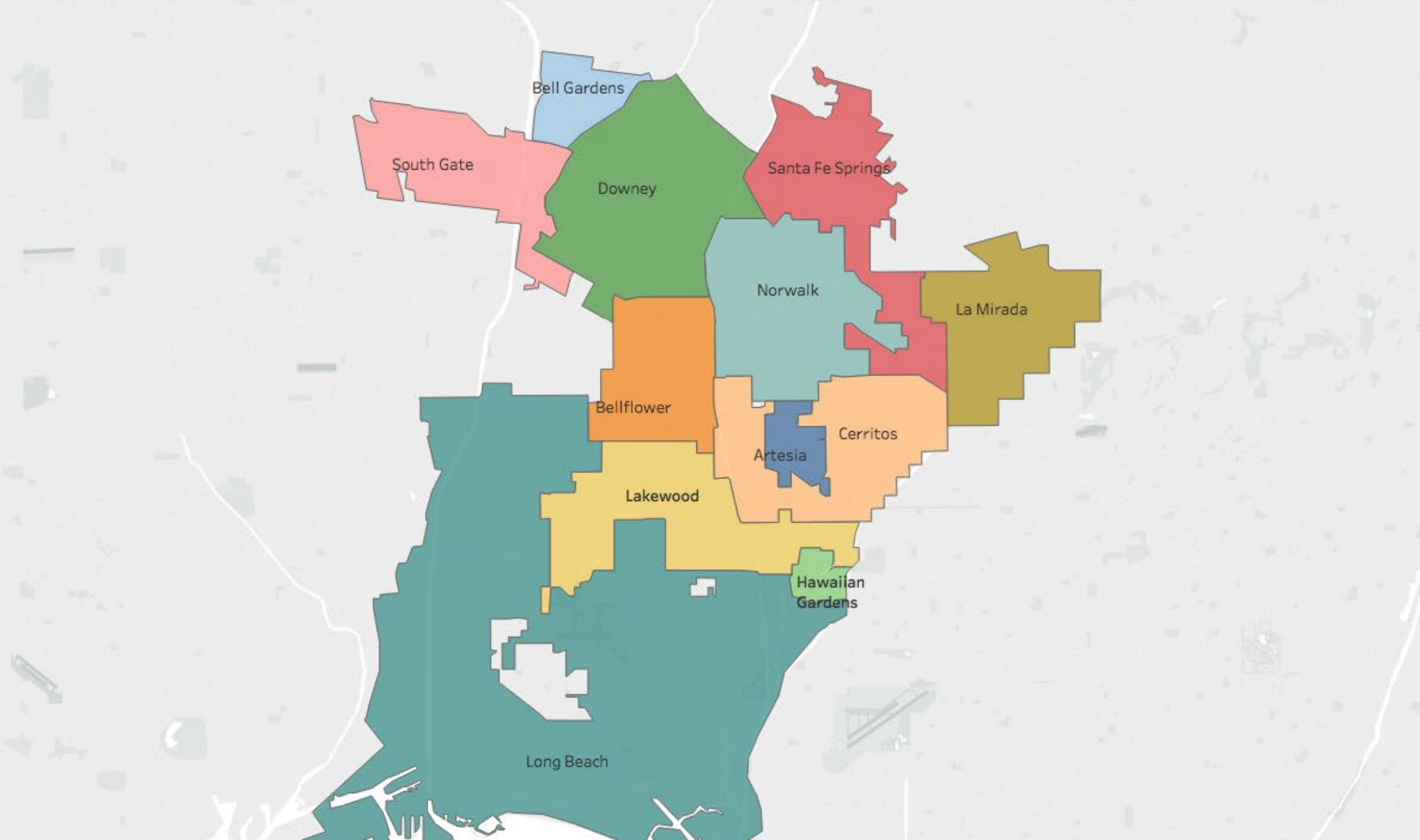

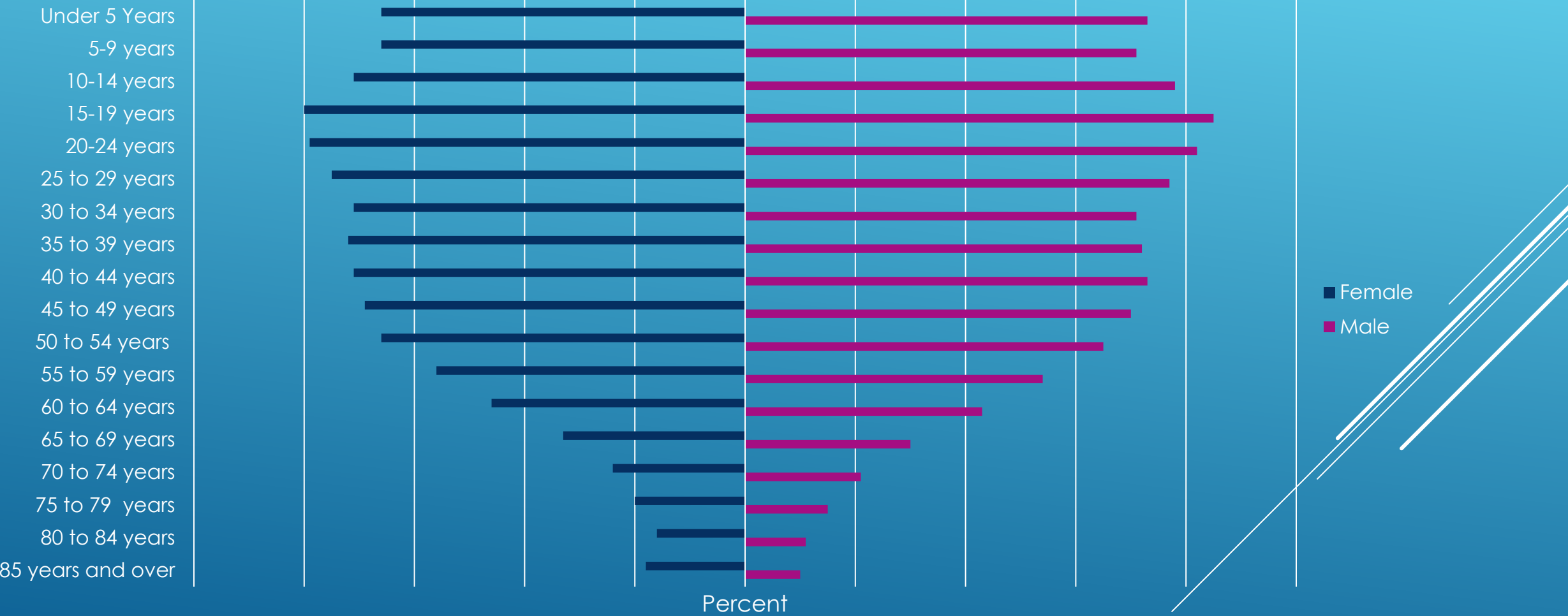

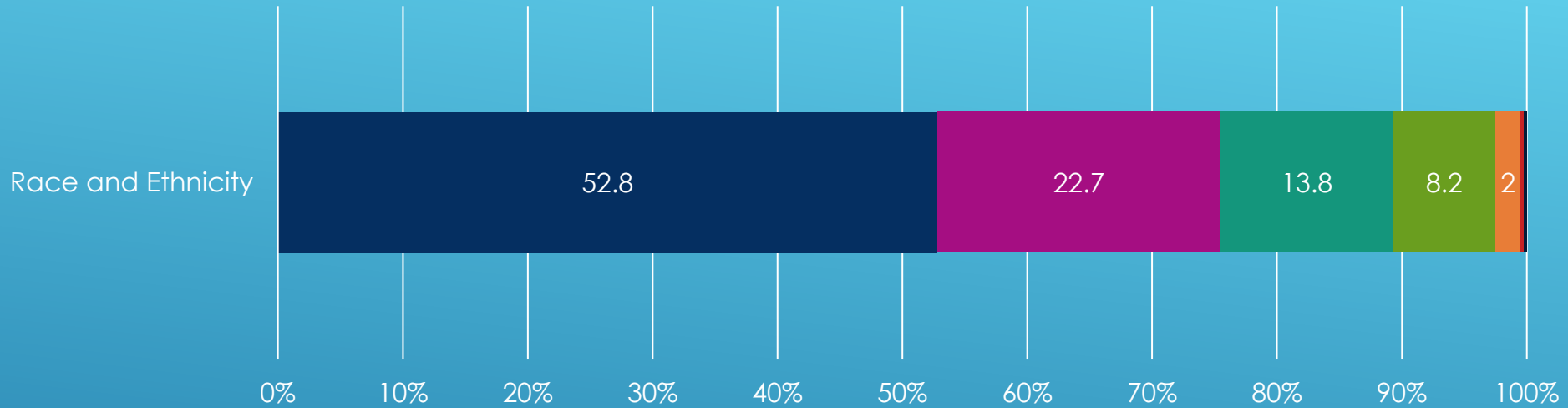

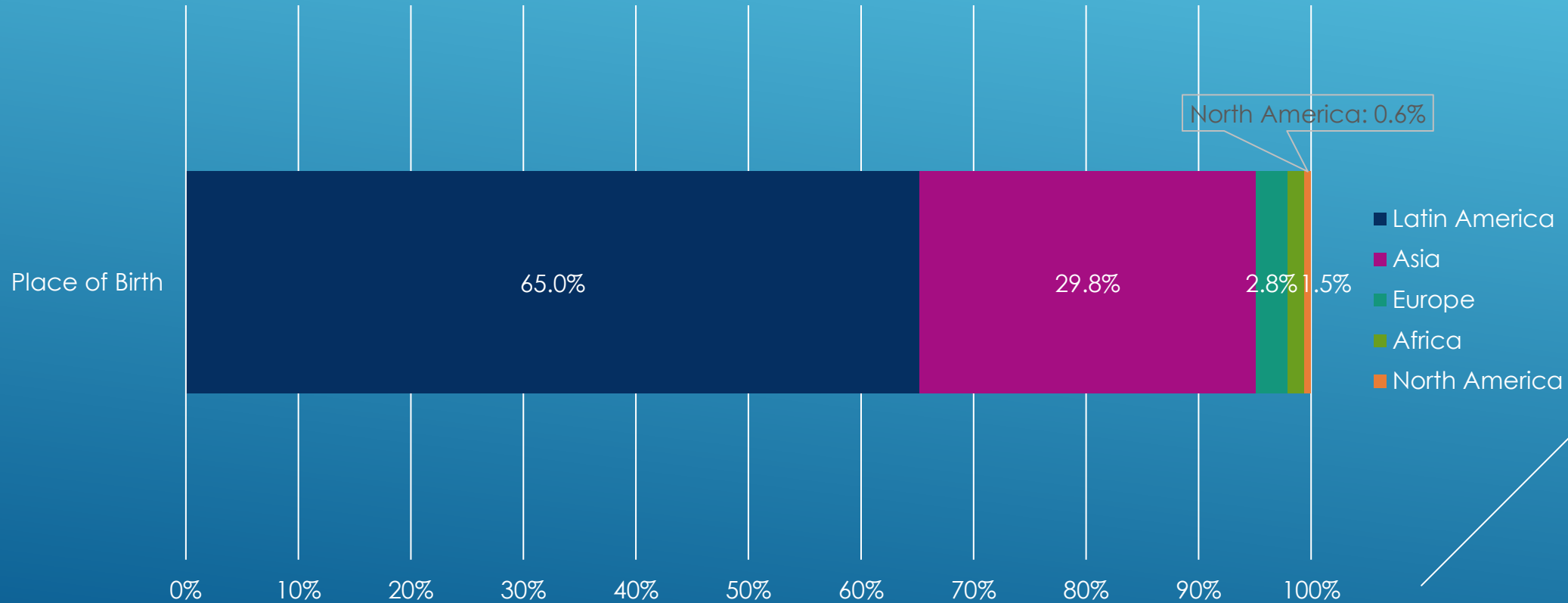

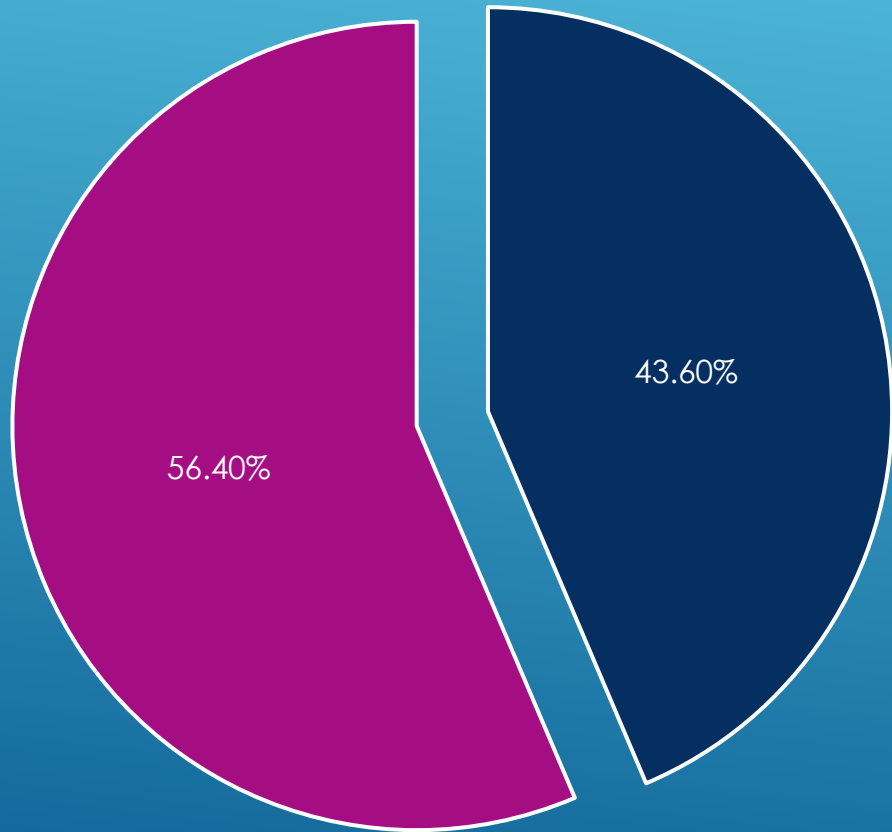

Language Spoken at Home, 5 years and over, 2015 ACS 5-Year Estimates

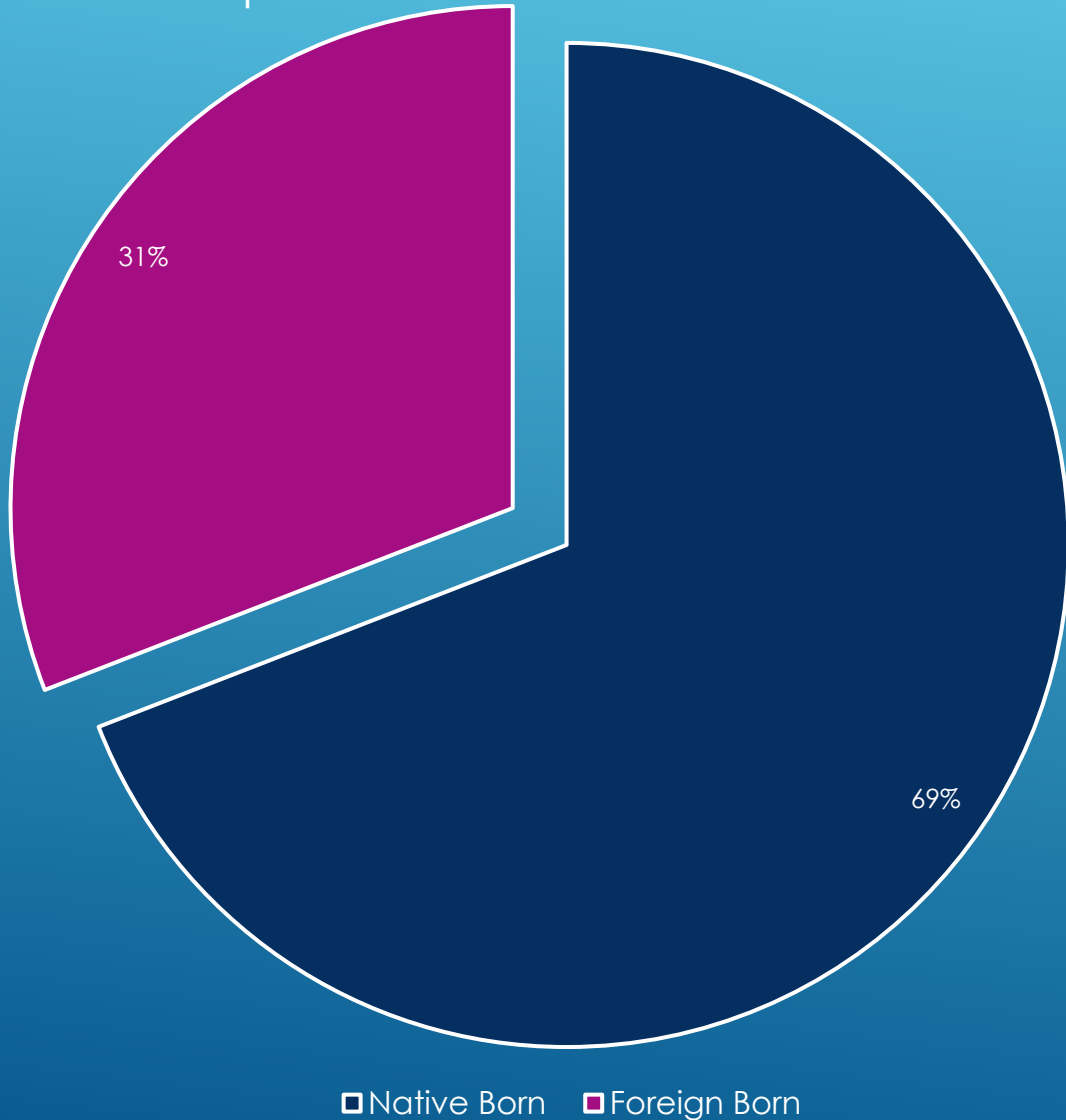

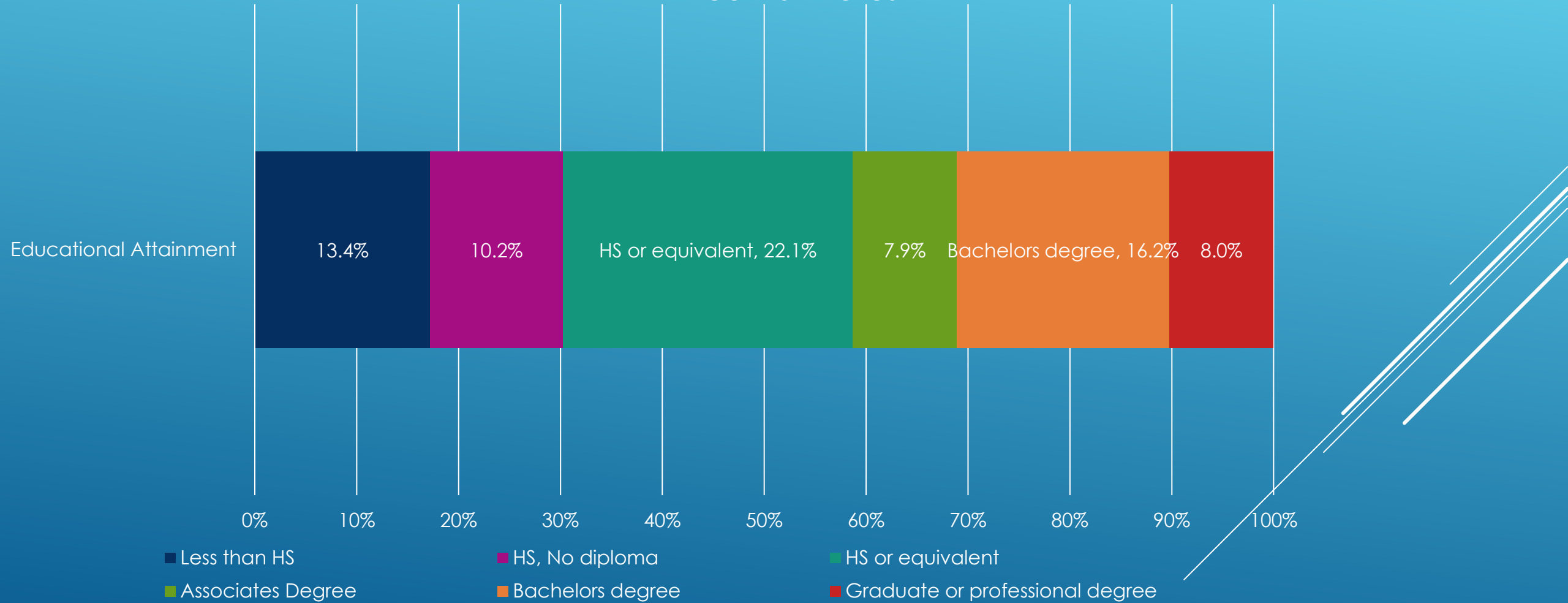

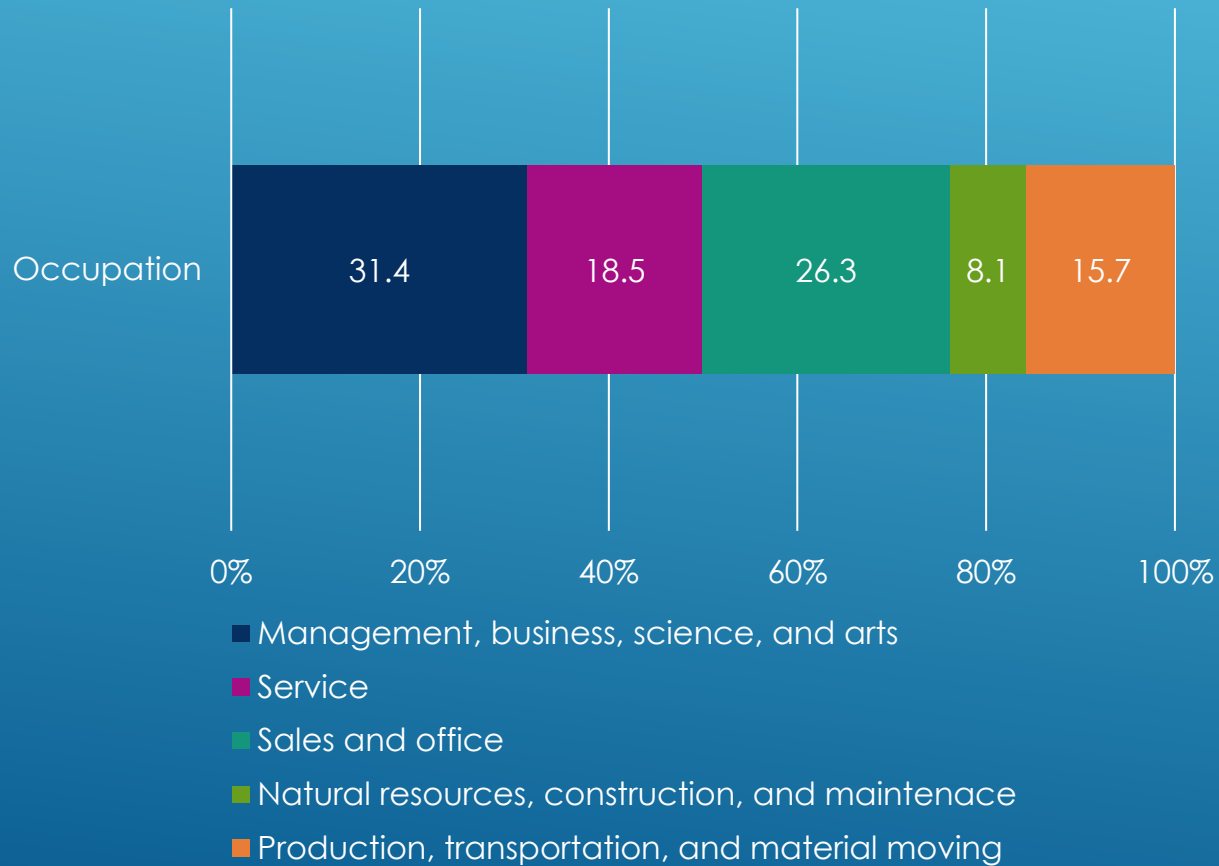

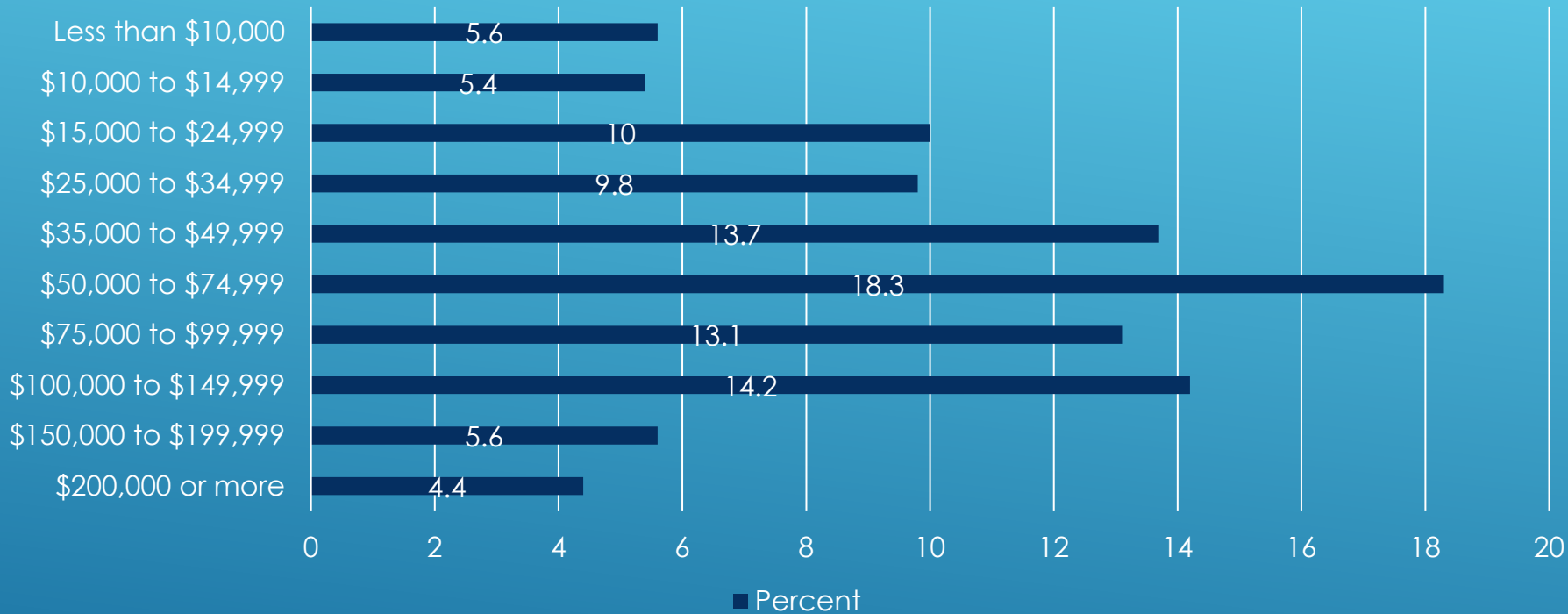


INCOME AND POVERTY

- Median HH Income: \$58,835
- Median Family Income: \$63,879
- Per Capita Income: \$22,147
- Percent of all people whose income in 2014 was below poverty level: 13%

SUMMARY

- ▶ This area is demographically diverse.
 - ▶ It has a relatively young bilingual labor force.
 - ▶ Residents in Gateway-area cities are more likely to work in education, healthcare, manufacturing, retail, or social services .
 - ▶ High rates of low educational attainment, which can be correlated to higher rates of unemployment and poverty.
 - ▶ People who live in this area typically work outside of their community signaling lost economic opportunity.
