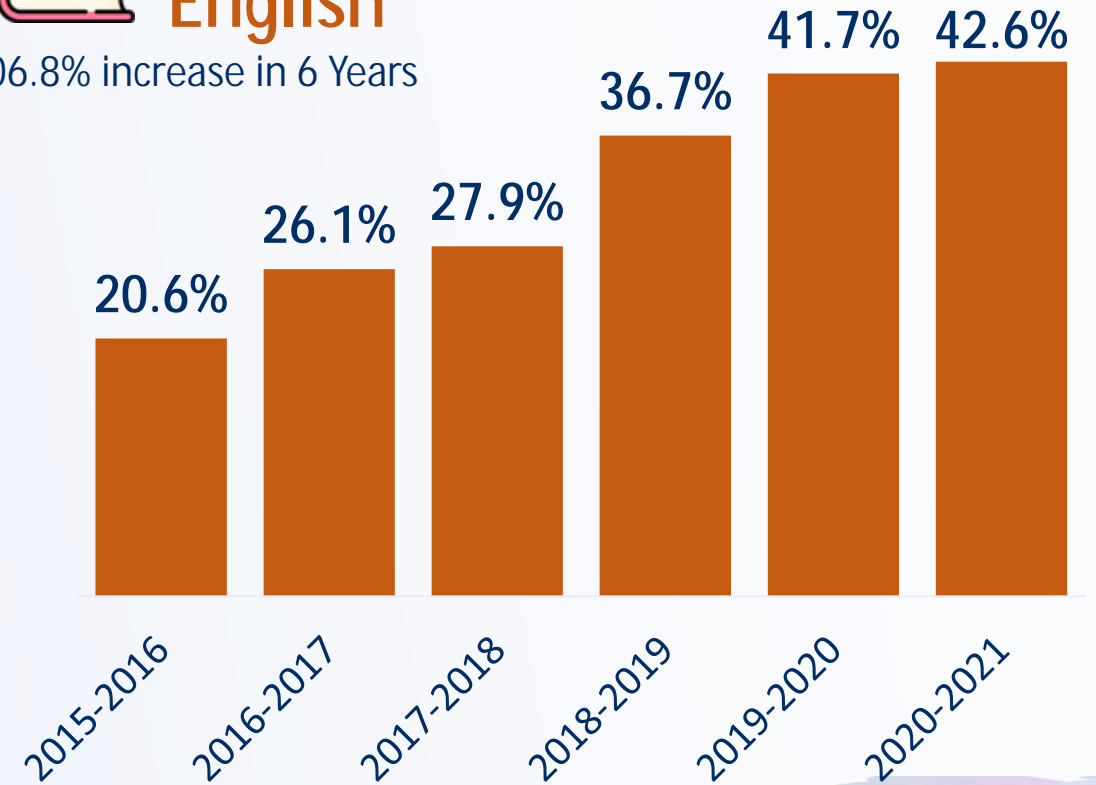

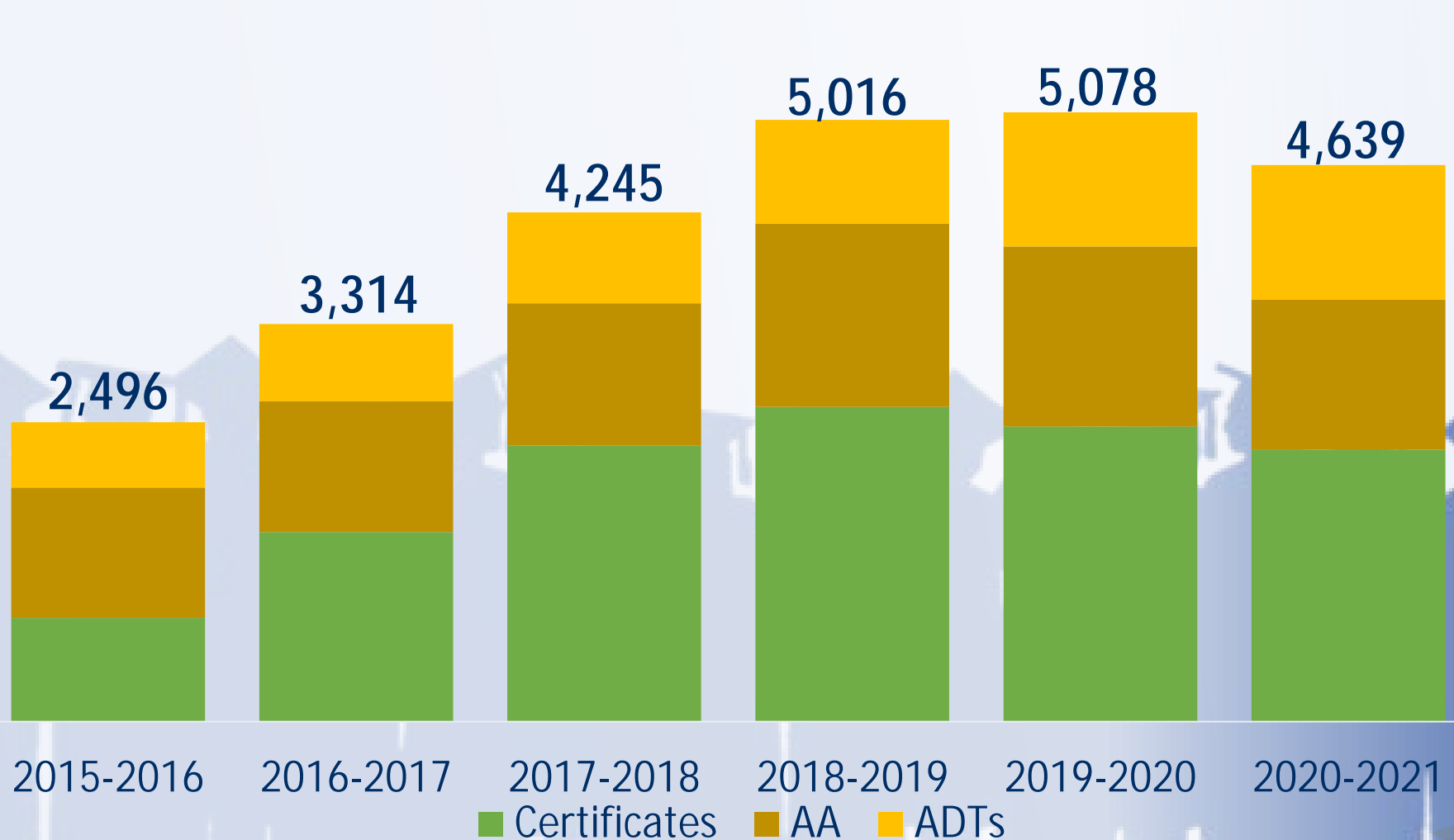

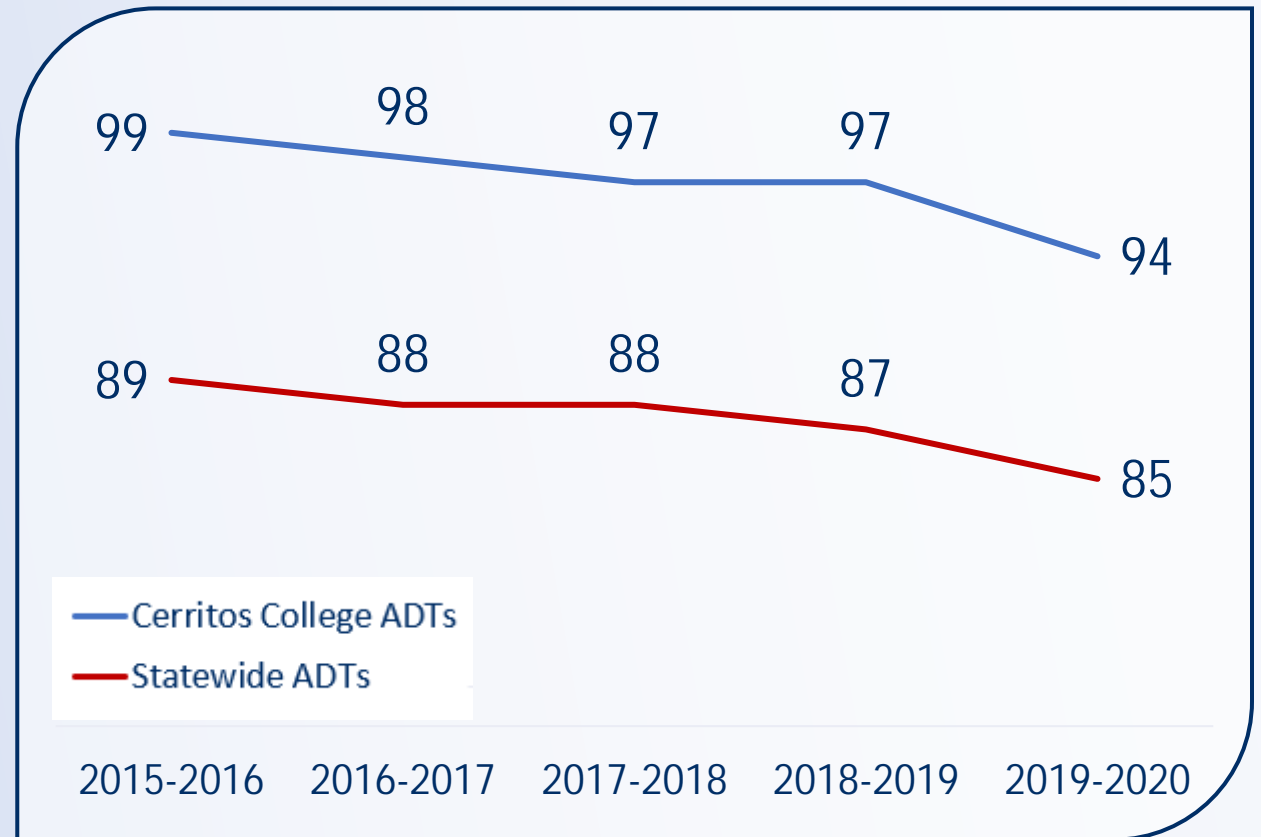

Graduation Rates: First-Time Students in 2016

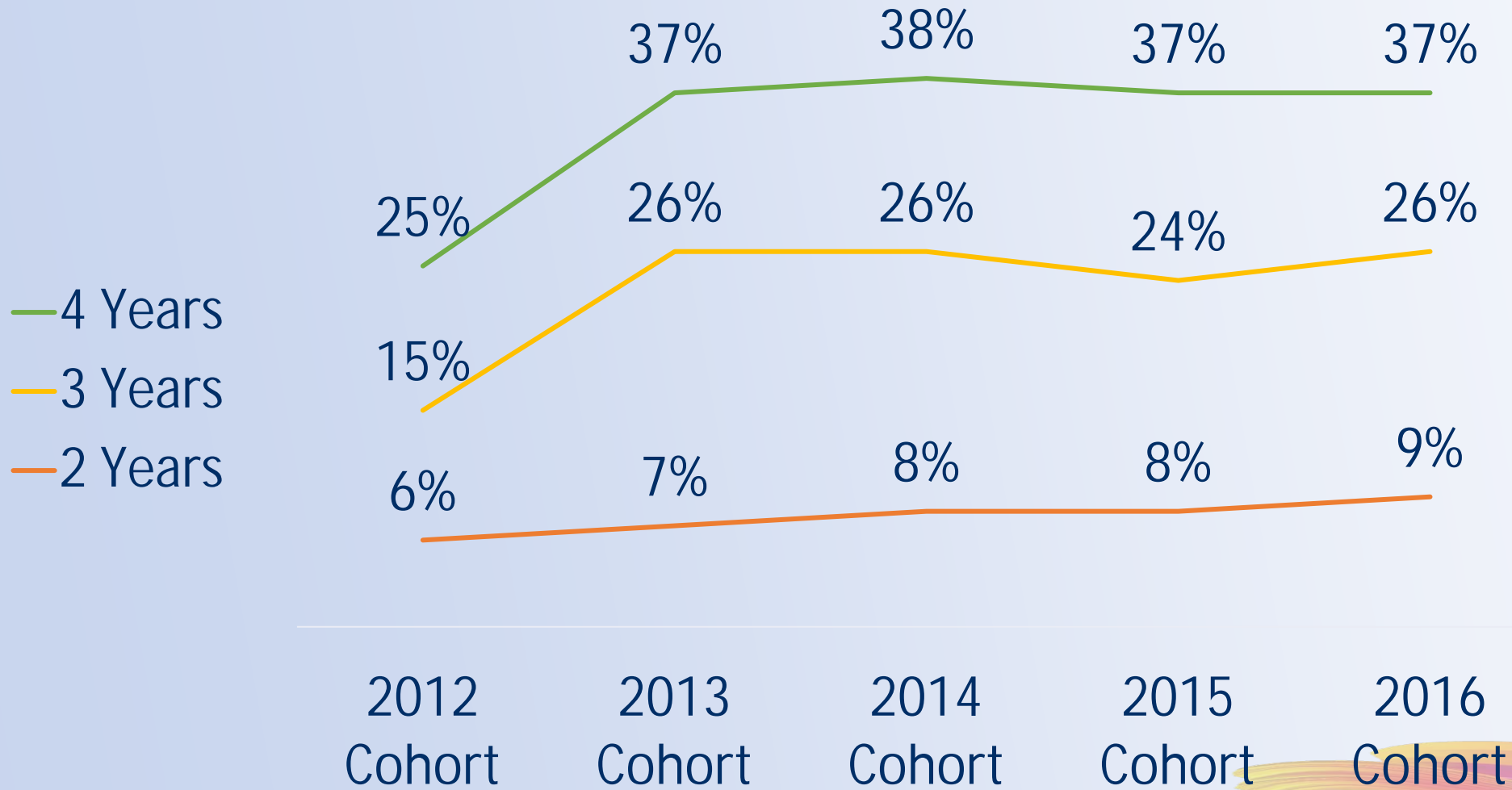

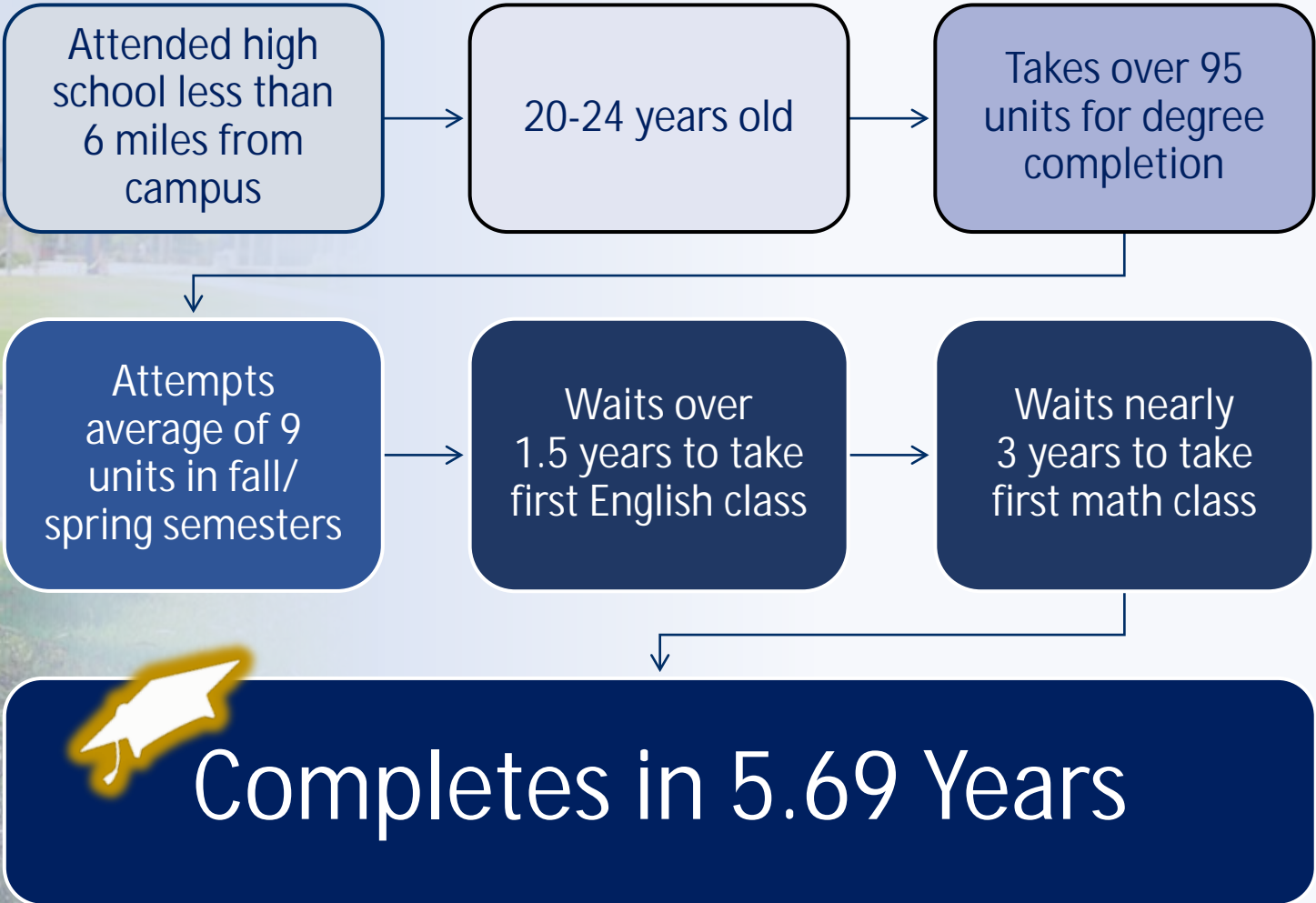


Graduation Rates

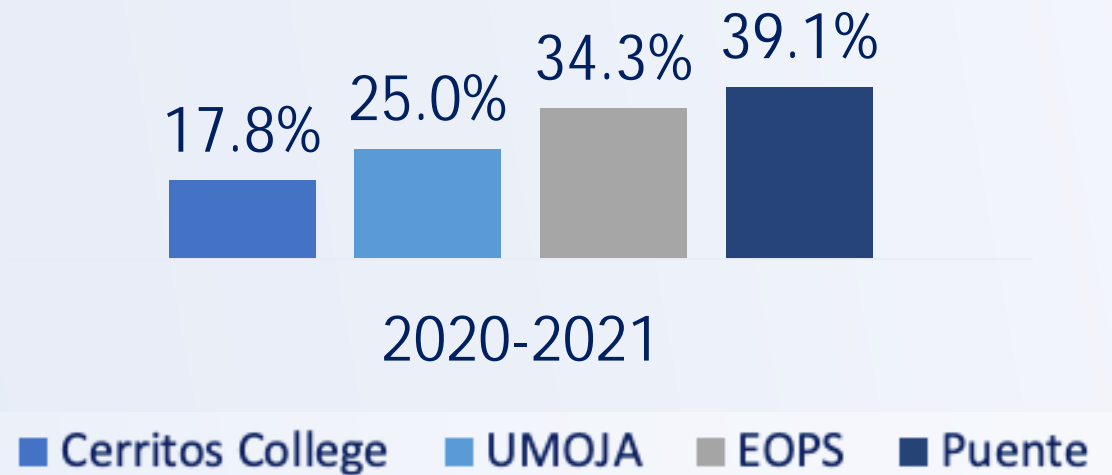

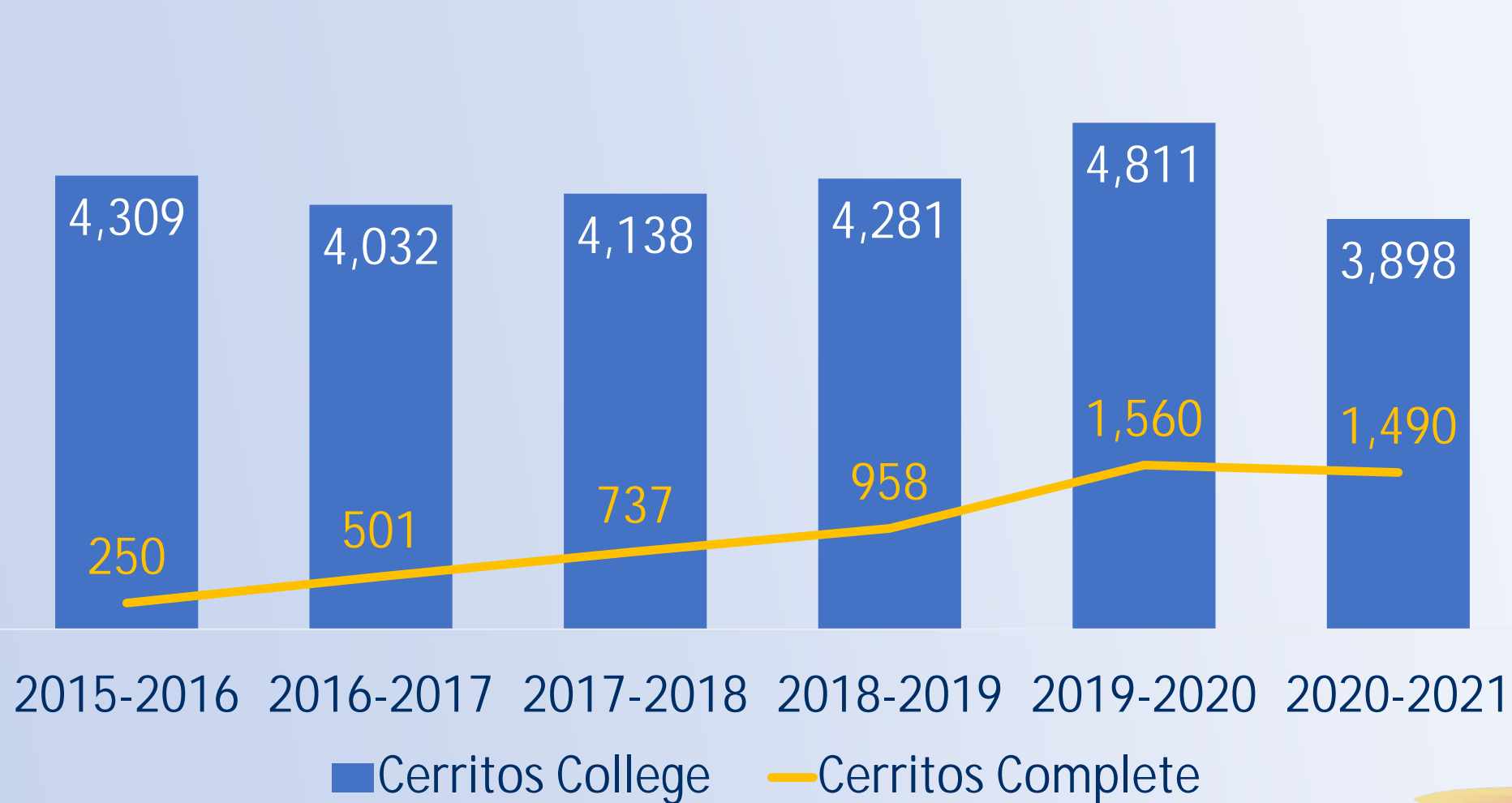

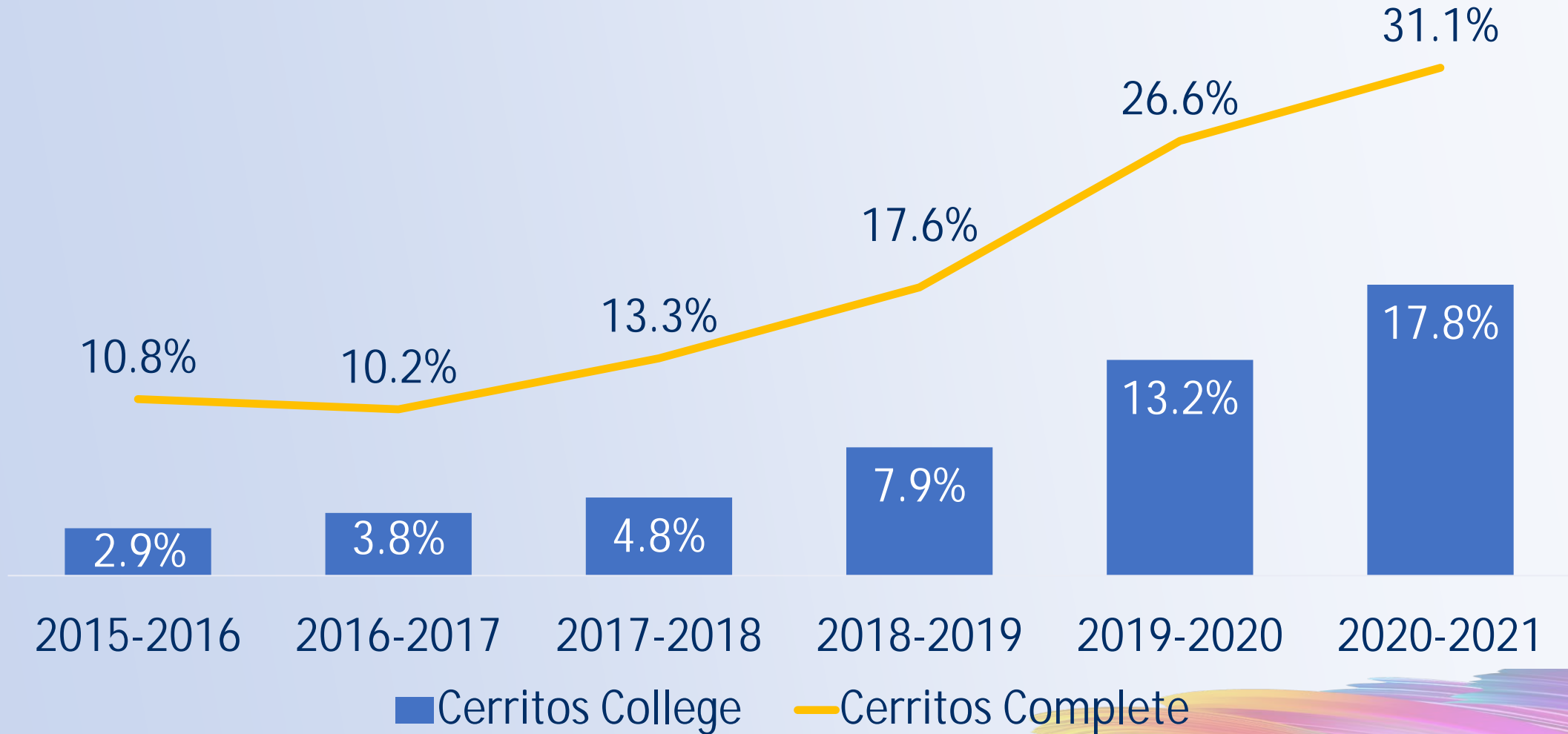
Scaling Success: Cerritos Complete First-Time Student Count



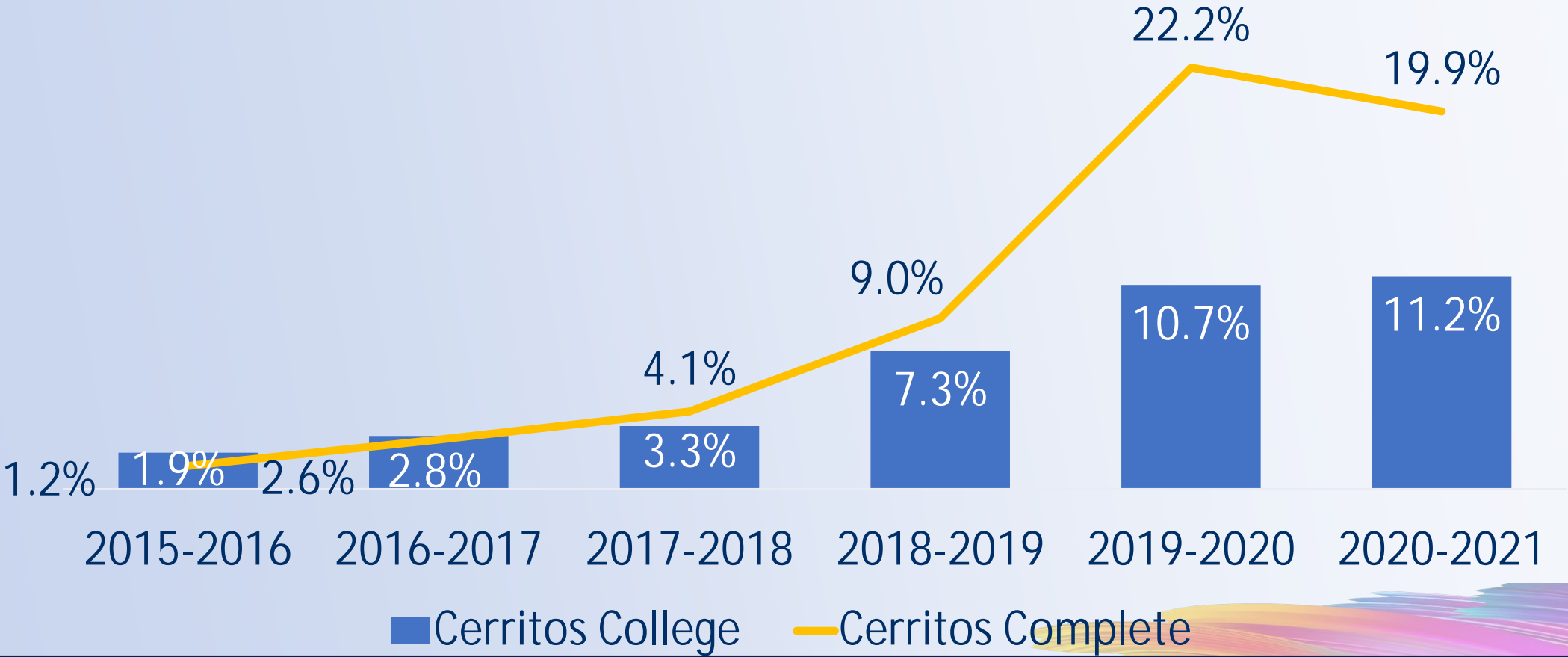
Over one-third of incoming freshmen are Cerritos Complete students in 2020-21.



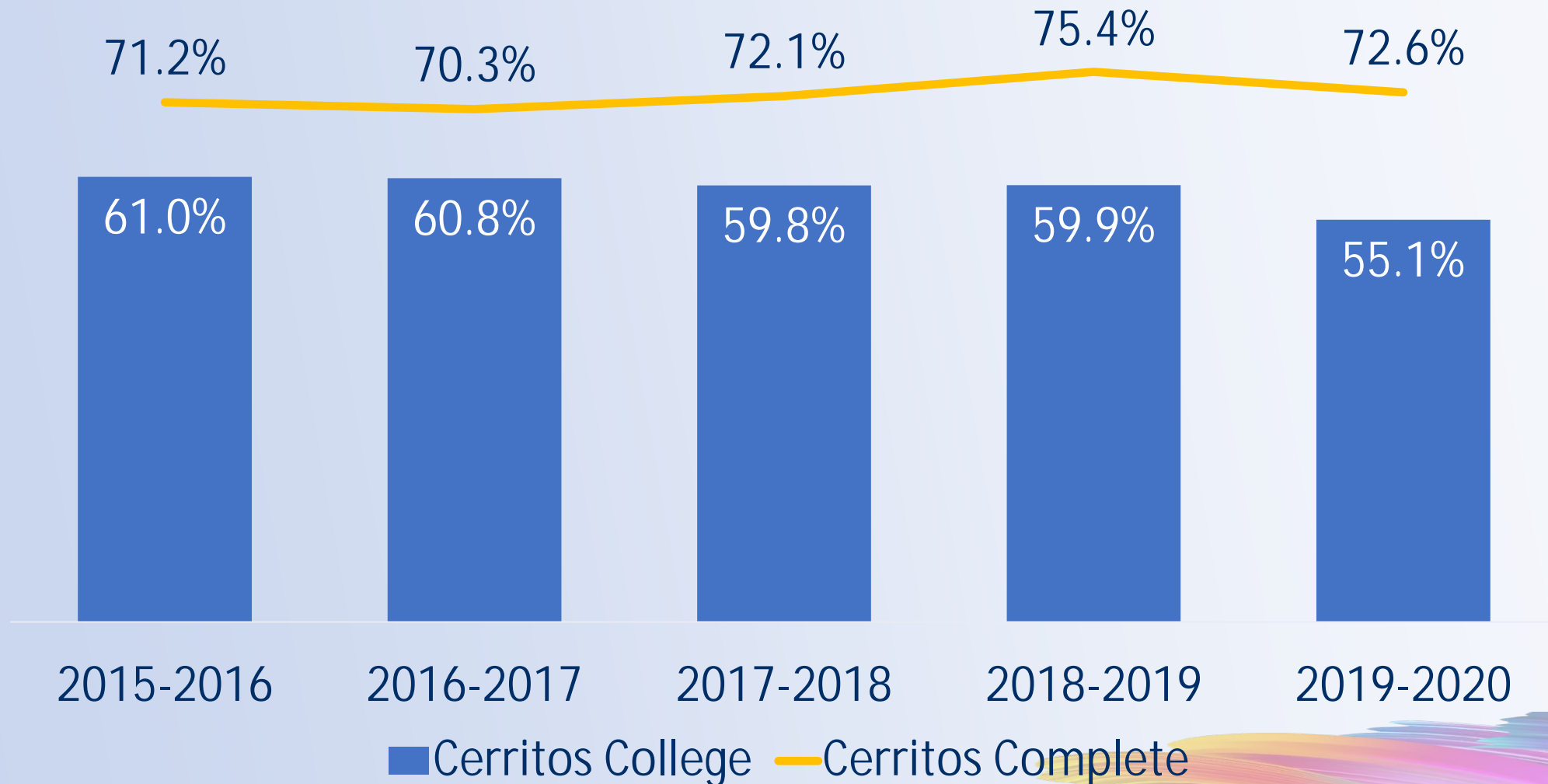
Scaling Success: Cerritos Complete Completion of Transfer-Level Math and English in First Year

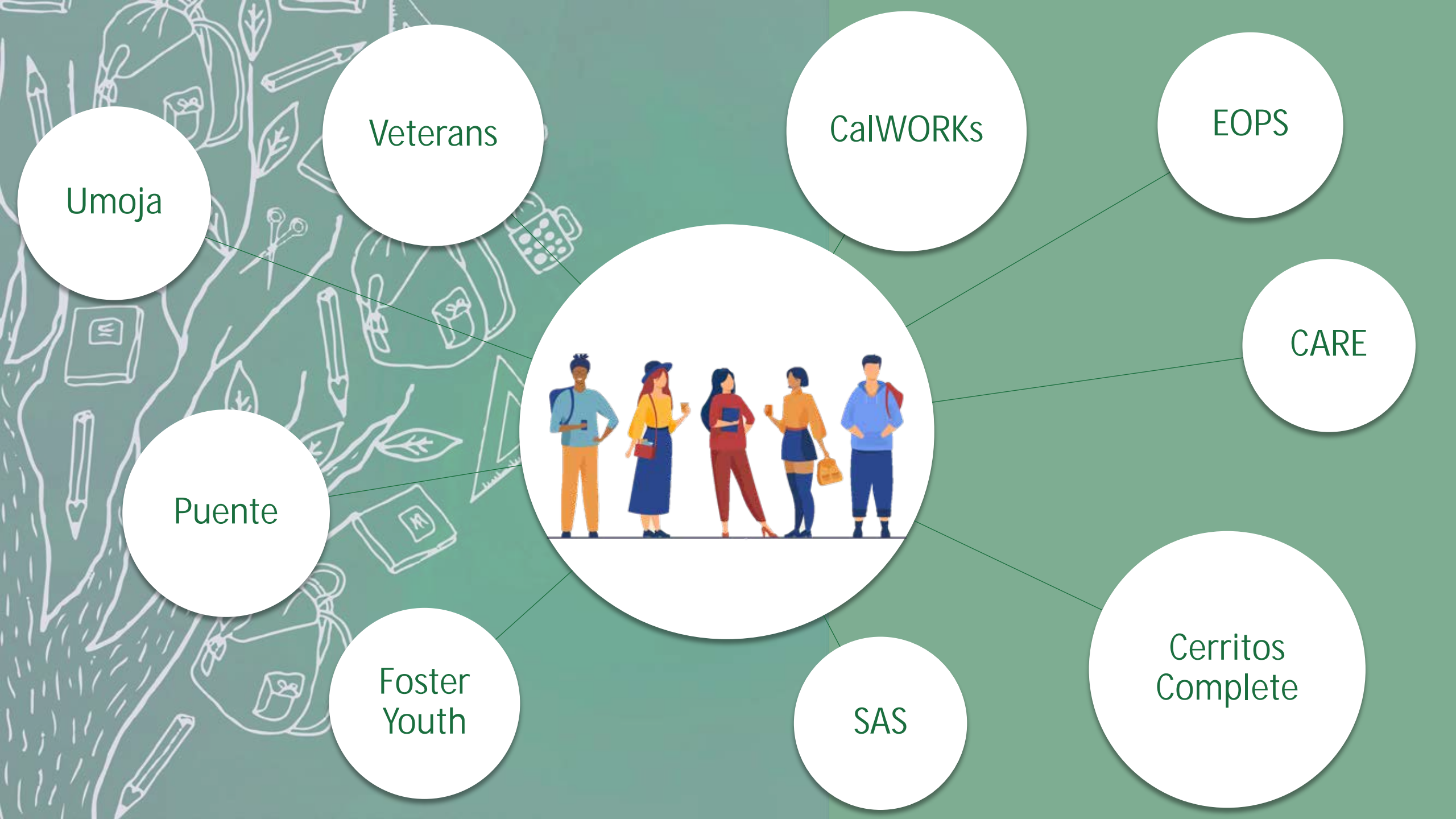


Scaling Success: Cerritos Complete Attempt 15+ Transferable Units in First Term
