1. IMMUNIZATIONS/PHYSICAL EXAM

Physicals (see list below for requirements of physical) are required by the Nursing Department and can be obtained for a fee at the Student Health and Wellness Center at Cerritos College. These service are only available for admitted students, however. An annual physical exam, TB test, AND Flu shot is required. Therefore, the physical exam, TB test, and Flu shot will be done twice while in The program.

*This does not include any updated immunizations or chest x-rays that may be required and needed during the program. This also does not take into consideration the replacement of equipment (uniforms, shoes, supplies) as needed nor transportation costs to clinical sites. In addition, students take pictures and composites for graduation in the 4th semester. Pictures would be an additional cost.
