CHIN101 - Elementary Chinese <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students communicate primarily with formulaic speech to list, enumerate, identify, express courtesies, agreement, and disagreement focusing mainly on the present tense and the proximate future within the cultural content.• Students create and respond using the language in culturally appropriate ways.• Students think critically by manipulating the basic structures of the language to develop meaning in listening, speaking, reading, and writing within the cultural context.• Students recognize and reproduce the four basic tones of Mandarin Chinese.• Students are able to recognize the Pinyin system and use it to read and transcribe Chinese.
CHIN102 - Elementary Chinese <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students demonstrate effective Chinese language communication and comprehension skills in a meaningful context.• Students write grammatically correct and pragmatically appropriate structure, and recognize the Pinyin system and use it to read and transcribe Chinese.• Students reinforce the basic grammar learned in Chinese 101.• Students understand intermediate levels texts in Chinese both written and oral.• Students recognize and reproduce the four basic tones of Mandarin Chinese.• Students demonstrate knowledge of the general aspects of culture, history, and geography China.
CHIN103 - Introduction to Business Chinese <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create and respond to basic questions used in the business environment• Manipulate basic sentence structures to convey meanings in a culturally appropriately way• Identify and reproduce the four basic tones of Mandarin Chinese• Read, transcribe and type Chinese with the aid of Pinyin• Recognize and write 200 Chinese characters• Demonstrate a general understanding of Chinese business culture and social norms in relation to language learning
