**CAREER OPPORTUNITIES:** Upon successful completion of the program, speech-language pathology assistants (SLPAs) can apply to the state for licensure. Once licensure is received, they can work as a SLPA under the supervision of a state-licensed speech-language pathologist. SLPAs may work in a variety of settings, including schools, clinics, and home health. Job duties include providing therapy for individuals with communication disorders, conducting screenings, preparing and maintaining therapy materials/devices, and performing clerical duties.
