

- Completion of **Cal-GETC** will permit a student to transfer from a community college to a campus in either the University of California (UC) or the California State University (CSU) without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower division general education courses.
- A minimum of 60 UC/CSU transferable units is generally required for transfer. For other transfer requirements, please see a counselor.
- Cal-GETC may not be recommended for some majors.
- Completion of **ALL** areas (i.e., full certification) is required for AA-T or AS-T degrees. CSU campuses only accept full certification.
- All courses must be completed with a **grade of "C" or better**.
- **Note:** Students with catalog rights prior to 2025-2026 may wish to use a different transfer GE pattern. Speak with a counselor for guidance.
