

**Title IX Ad Hoc Committee Meeting**  
**January 24, 2017 at 10 am in Human Resources Conference Room**

Dr. Raphael welcomed the committee and opened the table to individual participation in an ice-breaker.

**Minutes Recap**

Dr. Raphael reviewed the minutes from the November meeting. Dr. Raphael opened the table for the committee to provide feedback on the YWCA training and possible ideas for future trainings. The committee suggested offering a student training similar to the employee training on Creating Cultures of Respect and possibly having the Long Beach Women's Shelter offer training to individual departments on campus.

**Campus Updates**

Chief Gallivan updated the committee on the start of RAD trainings in January. Dr. Mennella updated the committee on a movie series that Julie Trager is hosting throughout the month of February to further transgender awareness. Amber Dofner updated the committee on upcoming STIXA training dates for students which will be held on February 3<sup>rd</sup> and March 4<sup>th</sup>.

**Title IX Coordinator Reports**

Dr. Raphael summarized the work that she and Amber have been doing for STIXA. Dr. Raphael will be assisting and participating in the Trauma Healing Circles events for Women's History Month. There will be 2 parts which will build upon each other, however, each may be attended singularly. The first circle will take place on March 9<sup>th</sup> and the second on March 30<sup>th</sup>. Dr. Raphael reviewed some of the highlights for recent trainings that she has given for new faculty and success center tutors. Dr. Raphael received positive feedback from the participants on the information received during these trainings and faculty inquired about additional information on bullying. Dr. Raphael met with Dr. David Betancourt, Center for Teaching Excellence Coordinator, on January 31<sup>st</sup> as a follow up on the trainings held. Dr. Raphael shared her experience presenting at the Black Student Athlete Conference in Texas with the committee. She also updated the committee on EADA/CCCAA data: sand volleyball would be the identified sport to start if there is enough student interest.

**Campus Safety/TARGET Updates**

Recent TARGET meeting held on January 23<sup>rd</sup> reviewed events during the Sandy Hook tragedy. The committee discussed the need for trainings on campus to help better prepare employees in the event of a similar crisis. FBI agent Jeff Cugno will be visiting the campus on March 10<sup>th</sup> to conduct a Mini-TARGET training.

**Falcon PRIDE Campaign**

Dr. Raphael presented the updated document to the committee for review. The committee broke off in 2 small groups. Group 1: reviewed organizational structure>there is established incentive credit for students and faculty to participate in events/trainings, but no incentive credit for staff. The group suggested possible comp time as an incentive for staff participation. Group 2: no edits suggested. Timeline wasn't able to be addressed. Committee will review the timeline at the next meeting.
