Campus Updates

Title IX Coordinator Reports

Dr. Raphael informed the committee that a peer educator model is being developed in partnership with ASCC for Title IX (STIXA). They are planning to have a 10 to 12-hour training in Spring 2017. Dr. Rich of CSULB is assisting with the training and is planned to be held before February 14, 2017. Gender inclusive bathroom forums are being held campus wide. Dr. Raphael recently attended a YWCA training to help with networking and outreach. Dr. Mennella was also in attendance and will be working with Dr. Raphael on domestic violence support for students on campus and working on CLERY reporting with CCPD. Chief is working on Nixle alert/messaging test - messages to be sent out on December 15, 2016. Next semester Dr. Raphael will be working on Safe Zone talks, focusing on transgender and bisexuality. She is also working on women's support issues with various groups on campus. A Target training will be coming up on January 23, 2017.

Falcon PRIDE Campaign

Dr. Raphael presented the campaign document for review to the committee, titled "***Falcon PRIDE Framework Draft***". In the document, Dr. Raphael detailed the framework of the campaign and asked the committee to take some time to help address the "WHAT" aspects of the campaign. The committee's goal is to have the Title IX website up and running by May 2017.
