

Title IX Ad Hoc Committee Meeting
February 28, 2017 at 10 am in Human Resources Conference Room

Dr. Raphael welcomed the committee and opened the table to individual participation in an ice-breaker.

Minutes Recap

Dr. Raphael reviewed the minutes from the January meeting.

Campus Updates

Chief Gallivan updated the committee that the CLERY crime log has been published online. Officer Echeverria was invited to STIXA trainings to speak about the RAD training program. On March 28th Dr. Raphael will host a lunch and learn to inform the campus on transgender rights and to formally introduce the transgender restrooms on campus.

Title IX Coordinator Reports

Dr. Raphael reported on the outcome of the last STIXA training. It was a successful turnout, the audience was engaging and interactive, and primarily consisted of ASCC and speech students. Due to student request, future STIXA trainings will focus on by-stander intervention. The last Student Safe Zone was on March 3rd. Dr. Raphael will be hosting a Title IX information table at the campus resource fair March 30th. Dr. Raphael will also participate in the Helping Fair on April 4th. On April 21st, Student Services will have a Title IX training. On May 12th there will be a Title IX Coordinators meeting hosted on our campus. Dr. Raphael is working on a Campus Coordinated Response to create a regional body, ensuring campus resources and contacts are not spread too thin throughout our local regional service area. Dr. Raphael is planning a *Take Back the Night* event, date and location TBD.

Campus Safety/TARGET Updates

Coffee with a Cop hosted by CCPD on March 2nd with a morning and afternoon session to address any questions or concerns from employees and students. The last mini-TARGET was held March 10th. Campus Safety Forums have been narrowed down to presentations launching in April.

Falcon PRIDE Campaign

Dr. Raphael reviewed the updates to the campaign made by the committee to date. Trainings will be held based on classification> student, faculty, and staff. The committee discussed embedded incentives to assist with the completion of trainings. Some of the incentive ideas for students discussed by the committee was book vouchers, shared-ride vouchers, bus passes, priority registration, and parking permits. Dr. Raphael presented website layout ideas. The sample sites viewed by the committee were University of Illinois, CSULB, and Santa Monica College. The University of Illinois' website was preferred by most committee members. The committee discussed using an anchor word to tie in all marketing efforts, and decided to use phrase "**We are Safe**". The committee's goal is **to have the site** go live by the end May 2017.
