Campus Updates

Amber presented the official event flyer for the "Take Back the Night" event to the committee. April 26th was National Denim Day, a day to honor those who have been victim to sexual assault. STIXA hosted an interactive event in student square in support of the day through an expressive art activity of decorating squares of denim.

Title IX Coordinator Reports

Dr. Raphael recapped the STIXA events that have taken place on campus to date. The Helping Fair was held on April 21st and had a great turn out. Dr. Raphael attended the Region 8 Title IX training along with our VP of HR, VP of Academic Affairs, and Dean of Student Services. Dr. Raphael hosted a regional Title IX Coordinators meeting on May 12th, updates on that will be given at our next meeting on May 23rd. Our first batch of information for our website landing page has been sent to Miya Walker. Dr. Raphael met with Miya Walker on April 24th to further discuss implementation of the website launch.

Campus Safety/TARGET Updates

Dr. Raphael reviewed the information shared at the last TARGET meeting attended at Pasadena Fuller Theological Seminary. The host college presented on their campus security/threat assessment practices. Homeland Security informed the audience of a free service offered to provide building safety assessments. Dr. J. Kravitz, from Cedar Sinai and professor at Pepperdine University, presented on the effects of brain injury and how it can affect behavior.

Title IX Deputies

Dr. Raphael reviewed the possible need for Title IX Deputies on campus by overviewing how deputies are utilized on college campuses across the country. The deputies on these campuses are utilized to help redistribute the incoming cases and workflow. The committee discussed how deputies can be utilized on our campus including possible areas to assign deputies, time factors, budgetary impact, and levels of responsibility. Identified areas on campus to possibly assign deputies are PE/sports, student activities, and faculty.
