

Title IX Ad Hoc Committee Meeting
September 27, 2016 at 10 am in Conference Room LC-135

Dr. Raphael welcomed the committee and opened the table to individual participation in an ice-breaker.

Updates

Dan Clauss updated the committee on the completion of the EADA report. Upon completion of the report he will meet with Dr. Fiero and Dr. Raphael on November 22, 2016 at 9am to discuss. Dr. Mennella discussed completing INTERACT with all athletes on campus. Next training will be on October 6th in S-201.

Title IX Coordinator Updates

Dr. Raphael has been visiting and introducing herself to departments on campus. She recently attended a training for ASCC, a training with OISS, TARGET training, the transgender student training in Temecula, recently presented at Faculty Senate, and will also start attending division meetings. Dr. Raphael informed the committee that there is a growing issue of “home insecurity” as a consequence to domestic and dating violence incidents. Dr. Raphael is currently working on a flow chart for processing complaints and working with ASCC and CCFF to appoint reps from both classifications for a hearing panel.

Minutes Recap

Dr. Raphael reviewed the committee’s three goals: Training, Communication/Marketing, and Processes. The committee moved into a discussion to review how to achieve these goals.

Strategic Goal 1- Training

Dr. Raphael introduced the possibility of having a trainer from the YWCA, Sheetal Chib, to come in and train the committee during one of the meetings. The committee agreed. Dr. Mennella suggested the October meeting, however, the training date is to be determined at this time. Dr. Raphael and Dr. Mennella discussed the ‘Break the Silence’ training with a panel including Chief Gallivan, Dr. Raphael, Long Beach Trauma Center, and Assistant District Attorney. Dr. Mennella also asked Dan Clauss if he could contact alum Olympic athletes to headline a video campaign for ‘It’s on Us’. The committee accepted the suggestion and Dan Clauss agreed to assist with contacting the athletes to ask for their participation with the production. The committee further discussed Green Dot trainings and Catharsis as other types of trainings that may be used on campus.

Strategic Goal 2- Marketing Worksheet

Dr. Raphael introduced a marketing template worksheet to assist the committee with marketing strategies. The worksheet components will address goals, strategies, audiences, and other pertinent information to help with completing marketing campaigns and productions. The committee addressed each section of the worksheet and Dr. Raphael will edit the final template for review by next meeting. The committee will review the template to finalize each component and assign committee members to individual tasks associated with completion of each marketing campaign.
