Many campuses are transfer friendly providing an opportunity to guarantee your admissions (TAG), offer transfer scholarships and accept CSU GE Breadth and/or IGETC. You may already be on the path to consider these options! It is wise for students to look at additional university options. Think outside of the box!

### Participating Schools

#### Biola University



Biola University is a Private Christian University located in La Mirada, California offering over 40 different majors and 80 different concentrations. Our most popular majors range from Nursing to Cinema and Media arts, Psychology to Business Administration, and Communication studies to Biological Science. Our wide range of majors and high academic rigor are backed by 82% of our students being employed or moving on to Graduate school within 6 months of graduation.

#### Hawaii Pacific University



Hawaii Pacific University is the Aloha State's largest private, non-profit university. Located in downtown Honolulu, on the island of Oahu, HPU offers an urban campus with about 5,000 students from all 50 states and nearly 70 countries. Hawaii Pacific University has a flexible transfer process and is ranked #1 in diversity amongst private universities in the U.S.

#### Northern Arizona University



Northern Arizona University is located in the mountain town of Flagstaff, Arizona, at 7,000 feet high, within the largest ponderosa pine forest in the world, where it has never reached 100°. About 2 hours north and uphill from Phoenix, only 1.5 hours south of the Grand Canyon, NAU students experience 4 beautiful distinct seasons. With about 21,000 undergraduate students, the average class size of a 3rd year class is about 25 students and 80% of our classes seat fewer than 50 students. NAU is a Western Undergraduate Exchange ("WUE") university so all accepted transfer students from California save of over \$9,000 a year off the non-resident tuition, so their total cost per year is about \$34,000, no matter what their major, and no majors are impacted.

#### Texas Christian University



TCU is a mid-size institution that provides an intimate learning environment coupled with the heart and spirit of division 1, Big XII athletics. Our most popular majors are business, liberal arts, and nursing but we proudly excel in our range of majors – from church music to ranch management. TCU attracts many California students to Fort Worth, Texas every year – maybe it's the generous and automatic transfer scholarships! Connect with us to learn more.

#### University of Colorado, Colorado Springs



Designated by the CU Board of Regents as the growth campus of the University of Colorado system, UCCS is located one hour south of the capital city of Denver, with inspirational views of Pikes Peak. Some unique and high needs programs include—Cybersecurity Management, Engineering Education, Bachelor of Innovation, Athletic Training and a new BA and MA in Social Work. The campus enrolls almost 12,000 students annually and proudly participates in Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE).
