CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY GENERAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATION AA DEGREE REQUIREMENTS 2020-2021

Cerritos College Counseling

- PLAN B is designed primarily for students who intend to transfer to the California State University (CSU). A student may use PLAN B to fulfill the CSU General Education Certification pattern which is acceptable for the lower division general education requirements for a bachelor's degree at all campuses of the CSU. Completion of this pattern is not a requirement for transfer to CSU, nor is it the only way to fulfill the lower division GE requirements of the CSU.
- A maximum of 39 units of lower division general education may be certified with the units to be distributed as follows: 9 units in Area A; 9 units in B, C, and D, with no more than 30 units in Areas B through D combined; and 3 units in Area E. For students who have completed the course requirements specified, Cerritos College will send official certification of CSU general education completion upon written request through the Admissions and Records office.
- Courses in Area A1 (Oral Communication), A2 (Written Communication) A3 (Critical Thinking), and B3 (Mathematical Concepts) Require a grade of "C" or better.
- Courses must have been considered applicable to CSU GE when they were completed. Some courses in previous years for CSUGE certification have been deleted; others have been added. See www.assist.org for effective dates. Students do not have catalog rights to a certification pattern, regardless of their continuous attendance status.

- Courses asterisked, although listed in more than one category, may be used to satisfy only one category. Courses marked with a CL are cross listed with another course. Cross-listed courses may only receive credit once.
- Courses in BOLD and <u>UNDERLINED</u> have no prerequisites but may have course recommendations. Please refer to the catalog for course recommendations.
- A student may use Plan B general education requirements to fulfill the general education requirements for a local, regular (non-AAT/AST) degree. To complete an AA using Plan B, students must also complete the Health & Wellness Proficiency requirement, specific coursework toward a major and electives, as needed, to complete a minimum of 60-degree applicable units with a 2.0 GPA. However, a student may not use Plan B to fulfill the Math Proficiency requirement for a local, regular (non-AAT/AST degree if they have taken FIN 125M, Personal Finance. They would have to meet one of the criteria specified in the Math Proficiency requirement for Plan A. Students should consult with a counselor if they have questions about this.
