Academic Requirements

- All prerequisite courses completed at a regionally accredited institution in the U.S.
- Grade of "C" or better in each prerequisite course.
- Science courses must be no more than 10 years old.
- No Cumulative GPA requirement however a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher is considered competitive.

Social/Behavioral Sciences	Preferred: PSYC 101, PSYC 271, SOC 101, SOC 215, ECON 201M or ECON202M. Acceptable: Any CSU GE Breadth course from Area D or IGETC Area 4, or PSYC 241.	6	9
Humanities	Any CSU GE Breadth course from Area C2 or A1, or IGETC Area 3B, or 1C, or ENGL 100 or ENGL 100S, or ENGL 103, or ENGL 110	6	9
