- 2.7 GPA
- One college-level English course

- Application Fee – Submit a \$50 application fee or submit a fee waiver (found at laverne.edu/transfer).
- Personal Essay – Tell us something about yourself. Make sure to proofread!
- Official Transcripts – Wherever college coursework has been attempted, completed, or is in progress, official transcripts must be submitted.
- Letter of Recommendation – Have a professor, academic counselor, supervisor etc. write us a letter about your work ethic and character. This can be mailed to the university, emailed to admission@laverne.edu. or uploaded to the application.
