CSULB offers Bachelor of Arts in Theatre Arts with **two** options in (1) Performing (Acting) and (2) Technical Theatre (Scenery/Costume/Lighting Design).

NOTE: At the beginning of the semester, all incoming students are required to audition or interview for admittance to certain upper division classes and are therefore used for appropriate placement of

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students at their level of competency. Students must fulfill running crew requirements within the first three semesters of transferring to the campus, see assist or details.

NOTE: New students are not admitted directly into the Music Theatre, B.F.A. program. Students interested in the Music Theatre, B.F.A. must enter UCI as a declared Drama major first. Admission to the Music Theatre, B.F.A. requires an audition; transfer students may audition as early as their second quarter in residence at UCI. This major does not require completion of prerequisites for admission as a transfer student.

Fall Admissions Only. There will be no mid-year admissions. Applicants interested in the Theater major must choose one of the following elective sequences on the UC Application: Acting, Design/Production, Directing, General Theater Studies, Musical Theater, or Playwriting. Admission requirements include required supplemental materials such as a departmental questionnaire, personal statement, copies of transcripts, resume of theater training, and audition/interview. All applicants

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must meet the admissions standards of UCLA and the departmental screening process. There will also be a fee for all auditions/interviews. Applicants may submit materials for consideration in one or more of the following areas: acting, design and production, directing, history and criticism, musical theatre, and playwriting. Applicants to the school must have a minimum **3.2 GPA** at the time of application and must complete their general education course work prior to entrance. Transfer students cannot change to a Theater major after they transfer to UCLA. For more information see <http://www.tft.ucla.edu> and www.admissions.ucla.edu. In addition, students must complete general education coursework prior to transfer.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES:

Preparation for the Theatrical profession as performer, technician, costuming, lighting, make-up, scenery director, and technical director in such areas as the professional theatre, community theatre, recreational theatre, children's theatre, and educational theatre.

How to use **ASSIST** to find your major preparation for CSU/UC:

1. *Log on:* www.assist.org
2. *Select an Institution:* select "Cerritos College" or other community college from pull-down menu
3. *Select:* "Type of Transfer Institution" such as "UC Los Angeles"
4. *Select a major from pull-down menu*
Report will show the university courses on the left and comparable community college classes on the right.
5. *PRINT:*-print by clicking on gold "**PRINT THIS REPORT**" button on top. Then use the **ASSIST** screen menu on the top toolbar or click on the printer icon that will appear at the bottom of the page.

How to use **ASSIST** to explore the majors available at University of California and California State University campuses

- Click on "EXPLORE MAJORS"

How to use **ASSIST** to figure out whether courses from the community college are transferable to the CSU/UC.

- Select the community college of interest (Cerritos College)
- Select either CSU transferable courses or UC Transferable courses
- Select a department for the courses in question
