This CSULA major has “major-specific admission requirements” which are focused on transfer student preparation that predicts success in the major and promotes timely degree completion. The criteria below reflect the current criteria as well as change that will be used for the Fall 2020 admissions cycle. The criteria listed will be reviewed annually for future admission cycles. For Fall term admission, coursework must be completed no later than the prior Spring term. For Spring term admission, coursework must be completed no later than the prior Summer term.

California State Polytechnic University – Pomona

A.B.S. in General Anthropology and a B.S. in Cultural Resource Management is offered.
