This CSULA major has “major-specific admission requirements” which are focused on transfer student preparation that predicts success in the major and promotes timely degree completion. The criteria below reflect the current criteria as well as changes that will be used for the Fall 2021 admission cycle. The criteria listed will be reviewed annually for future admission cycles. For Fall term admission, coursework must be completed no later than the prior Spring term. For Spring term admission, coursework must be completed no later than the prior Summer term. **Be aware:** Cal State LA currently only considers transfer students for Fall admission. Should additional spaces be available, Spring term applications may be considered in the future.

CSULA is also publishing courses that meet their diversity requirement. Please consider adding these courses as well. Although there appears to be the same seven course options for many majors, there are some exceptions so please check your major.
