California State University – Los Angeles

This CSULA major has "major-specific admission requirements" which are focused on transfer student preparation that predicts success in the major and promotes timely degree completion. The criteria below reflect the current criteria as well as changes that will be used for the Fall 2020 admission cycle. The criteria listed will be reviewed annually for future admission cycles. For Fall term admission, coursework must be completed no later than the prior Spring term. For Spring term admission, coursework must be completed no than the prior Summer term. **Be Aware:** Cal State LA currently only considers transfer students for Fall admission. Should additional spaces be available, Spring term applications may be considered in the future.

No other requirements other than the common lower-division preparation.

Students will be required to complete two courses (six units) certified as Diversity and Race and Ethnicity Requirements. These courses can be completed either at the lower division or upper division level. Refer to Assist.org for list of courses.

Demand for this major significantly exceeds space available. Students are classified as Pre-Sociology until they complete the preparation courses at UCLA. Students who repeat any preparation course more than once are automatically denied admission to the major.
