For Fall term admission, coursework must be completed no later than the prior Spring term. For Spring term admission, coursework must be completed no than the prior Summer term. **Be Aware:** Cal State LA currently only considers transfer students for Fall admission. Should additional spaces be available, Spring term applications may be considered in the future.
