LOWER DIVISION MAJOR REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIC TRANSFER INSTITUTIONS

California State University – Fullerton

Traditional BSN (Entry-level Freshman) program is for direct-entry freshman with no previous nursing education.

RN-BSN Program

This upper division Nursing Degree Program is for Registered Nurses (RN's) wishing to earn a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN)

Admission Requirements:

- Meet requirements for admission to the university as a transfer student.
- Completion of an A.A. degree in Nursing or equivalent.
- Current licensure as a registered nurse in California.
- Completion of college level prerequisite courses.

A minimum grade of "C" (2.0) in each of the following courses:

The School of Nursing offers 4 options for attaining the BSN degree that include the: basic pre-licensure BSN program, RN-BSN transfer program, Associated Degree in Nursing (ADN) to BSN collaborative program and B.S. accelerated program.

Basic Pre-Licensure BSN option is for students who do not have an RN license.

RN-BSN Transfer option is for students who possess a California R.N. license and an AA or AS degree in Nursing.

California State University – Long Beach

CSULB offers two bachelor's degrees:

- Bachelor of Science in Nursing – Basic
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing – Registered Nurse

The baccalaureate program offers courses that prepare the student to become a professional nurse. Two distinct categories of students are eligible for admission. The traditional basic “semester/trimester student” who enters the University without having completed a first level nursing program and the “registered nurse student”, who having completed a course of study at the first level, desires further study to expand her or his nursing capabilities to the BSN professional level.

Bachelor of Science in Nursing – Basic (program is impacted)

Students are encouraged to take as many as these courses prior to transfer as possible to promote timely completion of the degree at CSULB. Students should be aware that courses on this list may not all be required for admission but are required for the award of the bachelor's degree.

Bachelor of Science in Nursing – Registered Nurse

In order to apply for this option a student must:

- Hold a current license or be eligible for license to practice in California.
- Graduation from an Accredited Associate degree program or evaluation of diploma program for equivalency by an Accredited Associate degree program.
- Completion of undergraduate statistics course suitable for general education mathematics credit.
- Completion of an inorganic, organic &/or biochemistry course.

California State University – Los Angeles

Nursing-Generic/Pre-licensure/B.S.

The Pre-licensure Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree program at UCLA has been designed to prepare students for a career in Nursing. This is a three-year program.

The California Board of Registered Nursing has approved this program. Graduates will be eligible to take the National Council Licensing Examination (NCLEX) to be certified as an RN after completion of the program.

Admission Requirements:

- Completion of specified major prerequisites with "C" or better grades. A Statement of Purpose that includes an assessment of potential for nursing practice and a clear statement of goals after completion of the program.
- Recommendations from two appropriate sources (teacher or counselor or professional who has had a supervisory, educational or mentoring relationship with you)
- A minimum, cumulative grade point average of 3.5 in all UC-transferable courses
- IGETC CERTIFICATION
- Complete the University's American History and Institutions requirement. Consult the UCLA catalog

Admission Requirements:

- Applicants must have 90-105 quarter units (60-70 semester units) of transferable courses
- Minimum GPA 3.5 in all transferable courses
