Women have made significant contributions to philosophical thought since the beginning of recorded Western Philosophy. In this talk, we will discuss the work of women philosophers in ancient Greece, with a special focus on Hypatia, and how their work has been intentionally and unintentionally suppressed and (somewhat) forgotten from ancient times to today.
